Major Barter was a member of Headquarters, 63rd Field Artillery Battalion, 24th Infantry Division. He was taken Prisoner of War while fighting the enemy along the Kum River, South Korea on July 14, 1950, forced to march to North Korea on the "Tiger Death March", and died at An-Dong, North Korea on May 3, 1951. His remains were not recovered.
